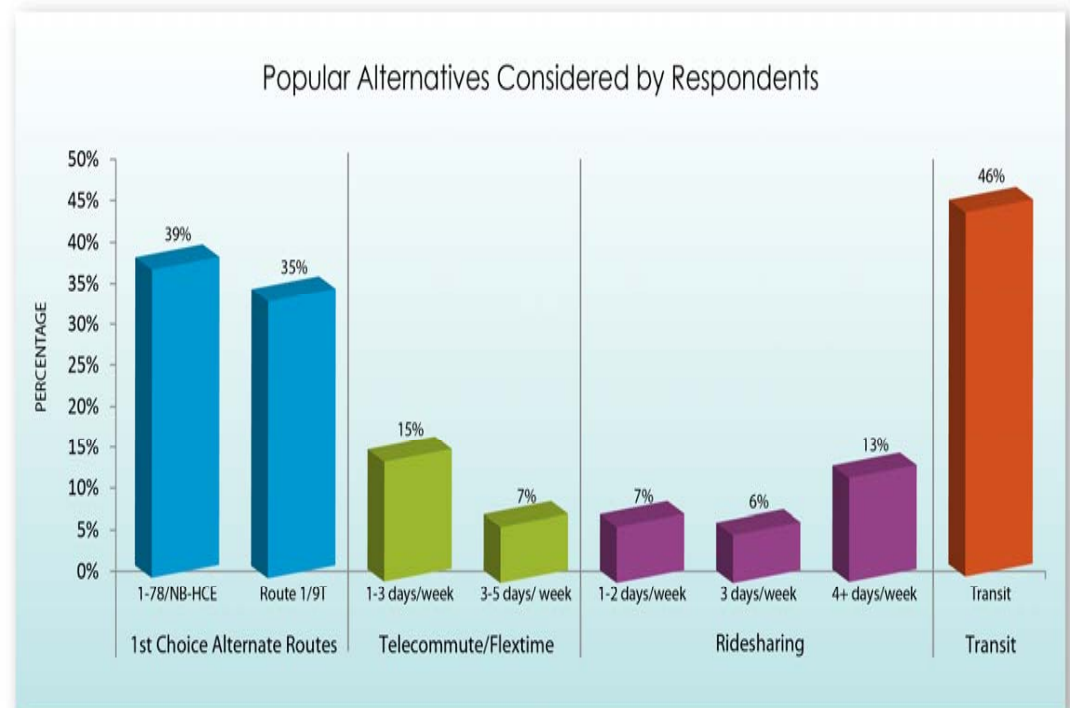

January 2013 Pulaski Skyway users survey

- Majority of Skyway users were going to Hudson County


Additional Options



We understand the difficulties commuters face when they carpool or vanpool. In our effort to keep car/vanpools rolling, we have recognized that it is common for passengers to be concerned about how they will get home if their driver has to leave work early or stay late due to an emergency. Additionally, the passenger may have their own personal emergency requiring an early ride home or a work related emergency causing him/her to stay later than the scheduled ride home with the driver. To allay these fears we provide the free Emergency Ride Home Program (ERH).

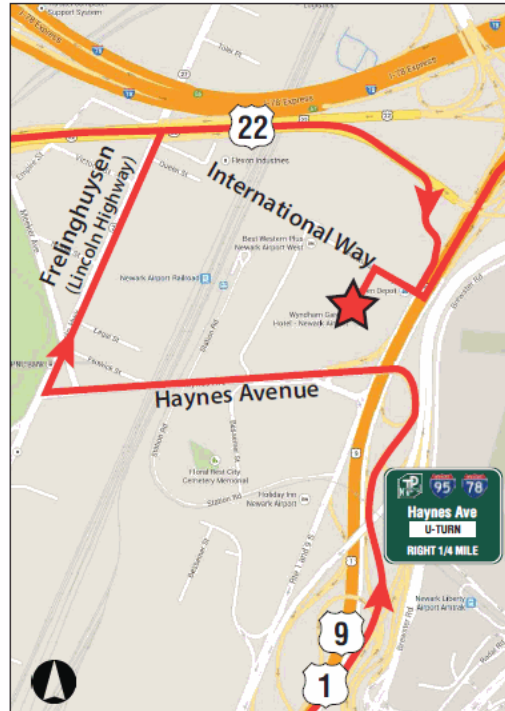

Grove Street & Exchange Place

From Northbound US 1-9

- Use 1-9 Local Lanes
- Take Haynes Avenue Exit
- Proceed on Haynes Avenue over Routes 1-9 to Frelinghuysen Avenue
- Turn right onto Frelinghuysen
- At the third traffic signal turn right onto US-22 ramp
- Stay right and immediately exit onto US 1-9 South
- Make first right onto International Way

From Southbound US 1-9

- Take 1-9 South Local Lanes and exit at International Way

From Route 22 East

- Stay right after Frelinghuysen Avenue exit and take exit onto US 1-9 South
- Make first right onto International Way

From I-78 EB

- Exit 58A 1/9 South
- Continue on 1/9 South towards Airport
- Make right onto International Way
