RESOLUTION #170 ADOPTION OF INTERIM ADJUSTED CONSENSUS 2025 POPULATION & EMPLOYMENT FORECASTS

WHEREAS, the Forecasting Working Group has been established by the PFAC to (1) achieve a general consensus of where the New York metropolitan region is heading, (2) provide a forum for the exchange of travel and travel-related forecasts (population and employment), and (3) provide guidance to the central staff in developing forecasts; and

WHEREAS, the PFAC adopted 2025 population and employment forecasts on December 7, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation requires 2025 population and employment forecasts for the intermediate update of the Regional Transportation Plan (RTP); and

WHEREAS, Congress requires NYMTC, as a condition of the Congressional waiver of air quality conformity, to adjust the adopted forecasts to reflect regional changes since September 11, 2001, and that these adjusted forecasts be used to conform NYMTC's TIP and RTP in 2005, and

WHEREAS, these adjusted forecasts will not be used in transportation planning studies that are already underway, and

WHEREAS, NYMTC staff needs to adjust the previously adopted consensus forecasts in order to reflect the Census 2000 and the economic impacts caused by the terrorist attacks on September 11, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the Forecasting Working Group has discussed and reached consensus on the adjustments made by NYMTC's consultant to the PFAC adopted forecasts (See Attached Table); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the PFAC adopts the interim adjusted population and employment forecasts with the understanding that such numbers apply for transportation planning purposes only.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the PFAC, with the advice and counsel of the Forecasting Working Group, will review the new set of forecasts for the years 2000 – 2030 when applicable data from the 2000 Census and other sources are made available.

This resolution shall take effect on the 17th day of July, 2003.
